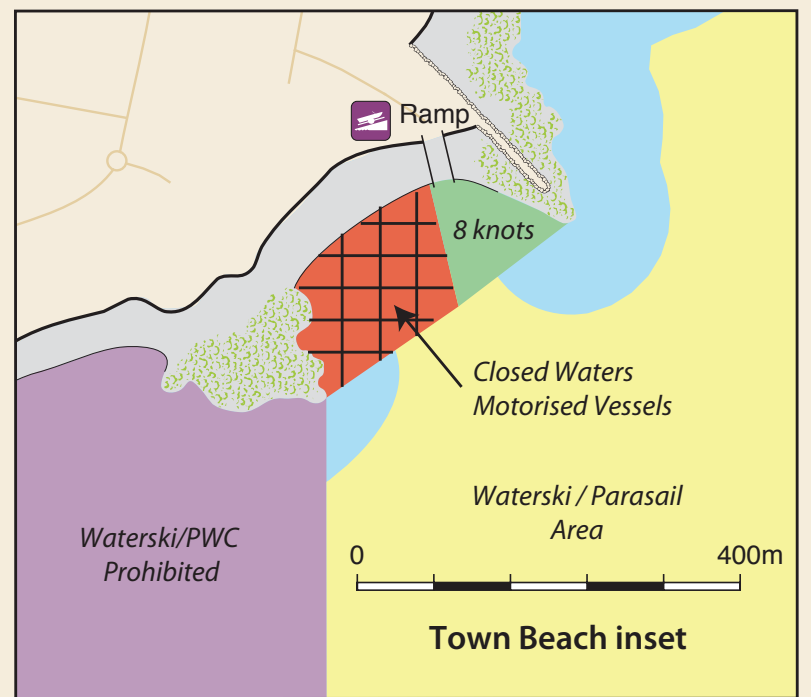

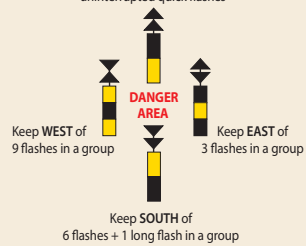

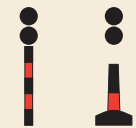
Cardinal Marks

Keep NORTH of
uninterrupted quick flashes



Isolated Danger Marks

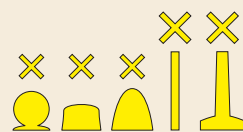
indicate a small area of danger.



LIGHT: White light, group of 2 flashes.

Roebuck Bay - Parasailing Area

Parasailing can occur in the designated area provided:

1. no parasailing is permitted within 100 metres of the foreshore
2. parasailing is only conducted between the hours of 0800 and sunset,
3. parasailing is not conducted within 100 metres of any vessel, person or object in the water, and
4. parasailing is completed by only using deepwater take off and landing.

Aquaculture leases and pearl farms

Aquaculture leases exist throughout the Kimberley region. The areas can contain floating or fixed structures and are marked by buoys and beacons which may be lit and should be avoided.
