Recommended Maintenance

Screen systems are a combination of many different substrates and therefore will be susceptible to normal wear and tear from the environment. Dirt, grime, air borne pollutants and salt deposits can affect the performance and appearance of screens.

Screens tracks should be washed down with warm water and a mild detergent to remove contaminated deposits on the track. Cleaning of the mesh can be carried out using a soft brush or soft brush vacuum on a low suction setting. Should the mesh become soiled only clean with water with no chemical additives. Silicone based lubricant should be applied to the screen track on every three months.

Cleaning of the screen must be carried out at frequent intervals. Failure to carry out regular maintenance may exclude the application of the warranty. The frequency of cleaning will depend on the environment in which they are installed.

The following maintenance levels are recommended for maintaining the screen's optimal operational condition:

Environment Type

- Mild - Rural and domestic areas, minimum every 6 months
- Moderate - Cities and light industrial areas, minimum every 3 months
- Severe - Coastal and heavy industrial areas, minimum every month.
